# ON-SITE VOLUNTEER PROJECTS

The United Way Volunteer Center will handle all project logistics, including gathering supplies, setting up the event, guiding volunteers through the project, coordinating an agency speaker and delivering the finished project.

## Fleece-Tie blankets

**Keep hearts and hands warm this winter.** Volunteers artfully (and easily!) tie two layers of fleece material together to create a warm blanket. Blankets are distributed to local nonprofits working with individuals experiencing homelessness, survivors of abuse and children.

- Each blanket costs \$13.

## Hygiene Kits

**Restore human dignity with the gift of hygiene items.** Volunteers assemble kits with a variety of personal items, including body wash, shampoo, toothpaste and more. Kits are distributed to local nonprofits serving individuals who are experiencing homelessness.

- Each bag costs \$12.

## Themed Bags

**Provide cheer throughout the year.** Volunteers create themed bags, such as holiday goodie bags, children's activity bags and back-to-school supply bags. Bags are distributed to various local nonprofits.

- Each kit costs \$14.

## Cards of Encouragement

**Pass along messages of support and encouragement.** Volunteers will create custom greeting cards with a personal message of encouragement to healthcare workers, teachers and other individuals in our community who help people live happy and healthy lives.

- Cost depends on total quantity of cards.

## Affirmation Bracelets

**Provide a reminder of support and care to those facing challenges.** Volunteers will create bracelets with messages of hope, motivation and encouragement. Bracelets are distributed to local nonprofits serving individuals who are fleeing domestic violence.

- Each bracelet costs \$5.

## Street Outreach Bags

**Gift basic necessities to those facing homelessness.** Volunteers assemble bags with a variety of items to help those living on the streets. Bags are used by the Coalition to End Homelessness and other homeless service providers to build relationships with clients.

- Each bag costs \$15.
