



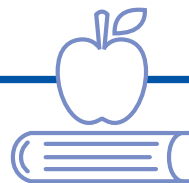

HEALTH

- 21 grants totaling almost \$41,000 were given to food pantries across 15 ZIP codes in Sedgwick, Butler, Cowley, Sumner and Kingman counties to fight food insecurity (*pic above*).
- 273,500 masks were donated to students and staff at USD 259 Title I schools.



EDUCATION

- 1,162 books and 300 parent reading guides distributed to 15 daycare providers - all with a DEI component.
- \$32,145 raised through #Fight4Literacy to provide books and resources to help local preschool through third-grade students improve on-grade reading levels.



FINANCIAL STABILITY

- \$20,000 donation to the partnership led by HumanKind Ministries to support affordable housing (with a UWP donor match)
- \$5,089,933 returned to local individuals through our free tax prep program and BEST Coalition of south central Kansas, as of March 28.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- Ian Worrell with INTRUST Bank was named the 2020 Loaned Executive of the Year.
- 87 teens signed up to volunteer at 16 local nonprofits over spring break.
- 77 nonprofit agencies procured \$106,904 worth of supplies for free from our Give Items of Value (GIV) program. 46 volunteers donated 197 hours to make those shopping trips possible.
